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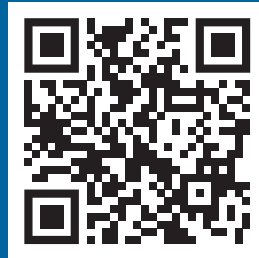

Colombia is the door to South America. It is a country characterized not only by its biodiversity but also by its environmental, geographic, multicultural and multiracial richness.

The capital of Colombia, and its principal economic center, is Bogotá. The capital district is located at 2,640 metres above sea level on the Bogotá meseta, on the Cundiboyacense high plateau of the eastern range of the Andes.

Universidad Pedagógica Nacional – UPN – is one of the 32 Colombian state-financed higher-education institutions and is located in Bogotá. UPN has always been a pillar of education in Colombia.

Dedicated to the education of teachers in different disciplines, UPN has become a reference for education, pedagogy and didactics in Colombia and Latin America.

About UPN

Universidad Pedagógica Nacional (UPN) was officially founded in 1955. Its appearance in the higher-education sector, however, synthesized the German pedagogical tradition represented in the Instituto Pedagógico Nacional para Señoritas (IPN, 1927), which in turn is the result of the first National Congress on Pedagogy, held in 1917, where the creation of the IPN was decided. In 1962 UPN turned into a mixed institution and took on the name of Universidad Pedagógica Nacional. In 1968 the Colombian Government reorganized the university into a state-financed teaching institution with legal identity, administrative autonomy and independent patrimony, attached to the National Ministry of Education.

At present IPN operates under the pedagogical and administrative guidance of UPN and has been awarded the highest distinction by the Colombian State, the recognition as Historical and Cultural Patrimony of the Nation. Nowadays UPN is the only univocal higher-education institution in Colombia. It is dedicated to the teaching of teachers with the aim of having an impact, through education, pedagogy and didactics, on the transformation of unjust and unequal contexts as well as of contributing to the construction of “other possible worlds”.
